Let's find ways to transform our networks of affinity, circles of friendship and trust into a shared wealth of the commons. This guide poses a question about what regional autonomy could look like and is an invitation for us to build an infrastructure that serves the needs of the people of the Bay Area.

Safety

Whenever possible do not call the police. We should not continue to participate in a system that reinforces racialized violence. One alternative is to get to know your neighbors and gather the names and contact information of people with a variety of skills. This way we can build community relationships that draw from shared resources and collective safety.
